

**2010 BRISBANE JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIP**  
**Wynnum Golf Club 14<sup>th</sup> February**

FORMAT

Each club is invited to nominate four players to compete in the championship. These players are exempt from competition fees. Other players may enter for a fee of \$30 per player.

A club representative team event will be held in conjunction. An aggregate of three of the four best team nett scores will decide the winning Club.

The Championship. 18 Hole stroke play

Prizes - Winner – gross score.

Trophy.

Expenses to Australian Junior to the value of \$500

Runner Up

Prizes to:

- 18 hole nett
- Nett runner up

Club Team event – 4 players

A player may win only one prize in the event.( Except if part of the winning team).

Entry Fees –

\$30.00

Club nominated players exempt.

Rules of the Competition

1. The 2010 Championship will be held on the 14<sup>th</sup> February at Wynnum Golf Club and will be conducted under BDGA Championship Conditions and these Rules.
2. These events shall be controlled by the BDGA match committee in conjunction with the Host Club using their Local Rules & "Decisions on the Rules of Golf".

3. To qualify, players must: -
  - (a) Be an amateur golfer in accordance with the Rules of Amateur Status as laid down by the Royal & Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews, throughout the period of the event,
  - (b) Be not more than the age of 17 years at the day of the event.
5. The competition is open to **p**layers who are members of golf clubs who are affiliated with Golf Australia and who hold a GA handicap.
6. Each Competitor, other than BDGA Club nominees, **must** enter on the appropriate entry form and return to the BDGA Office by the designated closing date together with the entry fee stipulated. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Match Committee. It is the players responsibility to ensure that all details are correct, including exact handicap
7. In the event of tie the winner of the Championship shall be decided by\_a sudden death playoff conducted over holes designated by the Match Committee of the day. All other ties will be decided by use of a count back. In the event of a ties in the team competition the winner will be decided by a count back using the highest scoring card of the teams. If two cards of a team are the same, the card to be used shall be selected by a draw. If still tied the next highest scoring card shall be used and so on.
8. It is compulsory for each competitor to use a golf ball and driver named on the current R. & A. and/or U.S.G.A. conforming list.  
Penalty for breach of condition: as per the Rules of Golf.
9. Where events are abandoned due to adverse weather conditions all scores are cancelled. The event may be re-scheduled at the host course or moved to another, if practical, at the discretion of the BDGA Match Committee.
10. The Match Committee of the Brisbane District Golf Association may vary conditions at any time should it be deemed necessary.
